- Please read the following terms and conditions before making payment:
- I understand that in making payment this is non-refundable. However, in extreme circumstances, we may be able to move your booking to an alternative date (at our discretion).
- Please be aware tracksuit bottoms, ripped jeans, leggings, trainers and hoodies are not suitable to wear during your training. Ideally, you should wear heavy-duty trousers and sturdy footwear with ankle support and protection. Please check the government website for further information on Motorcycle and moped tests: What to take to your tests GOV.UK (www.gov.uk). If you choose not to follow these guidelines, you are accepting that BMTC will not be held responsible for any injuries you may receive because of this and if the instructor is not satisfied you may be turned away and unable to complete the days course resulting in a loss of funds.
- I accept that my CBT day may be cancelled/moved to another date if possible due to extreme weather, illness, or unforeseen circumstances.
- I am not under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.
- You are also confirming at the time of your lessons that your license is currently valid, and you can participate in motorcycle training. You have made the instructor aware of any standing or pending points on your license and any court appearance that you are waiting to attend. Please be aware that failure to inform us of any points or court appearances may result in the cancellation of CBT courses.
- All motorcycles are provided by BMTC and covered by insurance and comply with the requirements for use on the roads, Students can use their own equipment and may be advised by instructors that it is the students' responsibility to ensure that their own equipment complies with Regulation EC2205/6. It is also the student's responsibility to ensure they are dressed accordingly and are adequate to protect in the event of an accident once again instructor can advise if the student is unsure.
- Students are responsible for any parking or speeding offences committed while riding any motorcycle owned by BMTC.

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
